Courses begin at \$495 for the PADI International Open Water certification. This includes all specialized hire equipment and pool costs for the course. Not included are your personal mask, snorkel, fins, and boots (we have some great student packages available in-store, and all our diving students save 10%-35% discount off the RRP). We suggest that you don't invest in your personal equipment until after your Instructor or our shop manager has explained the correct fit of these items.

Prior to the first knowledge development session, you will need to review information in the course manual and complete the exercises. A deposit of just \$100 will get you started.

Before you learn to dive, you must have a Scuba Diving Medical. Please contact us for more information and the medical forms you'll need to take to the doctor.
