**Time for completion:** One evening and two days

### What is involved:

- Theory session: learn techniques for diving & exploring shipwrecks, and how to avoid common hazards
- Understand legal issues
- Learn how to research and learn the background of your favorite wrecks
- Wreck scuba diving equipment considerations
- Considerations and techniques for entering intact wrecks
- Gain experience in planning, organizing and making at least four wreck dives under the supervision of a PADI Instructor. The four dives will be conducted on the ex-HMAS Hobart.

- The PADI Wreck Diver theory manual
- Personal Scuba Equipment
- Dive Computer (recommended, not included in cost)
- Reel, 2 torches, knife, slate (not included in cost)
